■ EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS GENERAL RULES

7.1 The BALKAN CYCLING UNION in cooperation with aPedalForward & ROMANIAN Cycling Federation organize the 2023 BCU Cyclo-Cross BALKANIK Championships held on 20 January in Vatra Dornei (Romania).

7.2 The event will be organized in accordance with the rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.

7.3 The Championships (Cadets/Juniors/Elite) may be contested by riders entered by their National Federation as a National Team.

7.4 The riders (Juniors/U23/Elite) to contest each Championship shall be confirmed by an official of their Federation to the Commissaires during the confirmation procedure, before the start of the Team Managers meeting.

7.6 Riders ages shall be calculated as defined by the UCI rules (5.1.001). The category which will be applied for entries to races for the entire season is the category to which the rider will belong on 1 January of the following calendar year.

7.7 Body numbers – Clothes

The riders are obliged to use the body-numbers which will be supplied by the organization. Changes to these and clothes are not allowed. Riders must compete in their national jersey (where applicable).

7.8 Unforeseen

In those cases in which the regulations do not specify, the commissaires panel, in conjunction with the BCU Technical delegate and the organization (where applicable), will decide.

STARTING ORDER

OTHER UCI-RULES

The start order for ME, WE, MJ and WJ categories will be as follows:

As per the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross individual classification of the current season.

Unclassified riders by nations' rotation as follows:

- For unclassified riders, the start order within the team must be confirmed by the national federations during rider's confirmation and the order will be determined by drawing lots.

The start order for MC, WC will be as follows:

- The start order within the team must be confirmed by the national federations during rider's confirmation and the order will be determined by drawing lots.

CLOTHING

All riders of ME, WE, MJ, WJ, MC and WC categories must start in their national jerseys (art.1.3.059).

The advertisements on jerseys have to be in conformity with art. 1.3.057 of UCI regulations.

OTHER UCI-RULES

1. Wearing a rigid safety helmet shall be mandatory during competitions and training sessions.
2. Bicycles used for Cyclo-Cross races must comply with UCI regulations.
3. For the Cyclo-Cross bicycle the width of the tyres (measured between the widest parts) shall not exceed 33 mm and it may not incorporate any form of spike or stud (1.3.018).
4. Using of disc brakes are allowed in cyclo-cross training and competition (1.3.025).
5. For races on the road and cyclo-cross, the use of fixed sprocket is forbidden: a braking system that acts on both wheels is required.
6. The article on the maximum gear ratio for junior is not valid for Cyclo-cross events.
7. Personal high-pressure cleaners are forbidden in the pit area during.

AWARD CEREMONIES / JERSEY & MEDALS

Every Balkanik Championship will be awarded for:

The 1st place: Champion jersey and Gold medal

The 2nd place: Silver medal

The 3rd place: Bronze medal

ANTIDOPING

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The antidoping tests will take place at the Antidoping Station located in:

Antidoping Room – in Cazinoul Balnear Vatra Dornei.

PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

11

RESPONSABILITIES

The Organizer and BCU will not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

The organizers and BCU decline all responsibilities towards the riders and others in case of an accident.

For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply. Any problems will be solved between the organizers, the Commissaires Panel and BCU officials.
